

Congratulations, you have achieved AE! Now what?

1. Get to Work & Gain Experience

You have 8 years to apply for CCPE if applying under the 4 year category, and 10 years to apply under the 5 year category.

2. Build your Application

Applications are accepted in March and September of each year.

Check www.cccpe.ca for the most up to date application kit.

Professional Experience Duration (PED):

Obtain at least 4 years (48 months) including at least 1 year with a mentor **OR** 5 years (60 months) of professional work experience in ergonomics/human factors. At [least 50% of professional activities](#) must have been in the direct application of ergonomics/human factors for it to count.

Professional Competencies (PC):

Gain the necessary experience and competencies by completing assessments and projects that demonstrate at least 12 of the 17 PCs.

Employment History Log:

Document all employment showing the percent of time in direct application of ergonomics/human factors. Review the application kit to ensure that work experience gained prior to AE designation, during enrolment in an educational program, or representing less than 100% of practice has been discounted properly.

Work Products:

- Minimum: 3
- Maximum # of pages: 100
- Minimum of 12 professional competencies demonstrated incl. mandatory (1, 2, 6, 9, 13 & 15) competencies with awareness of multiple disciplines
- Covers a breadth of work experience
- Provide a summary for each work product
- Professional competencies must be tagged within each work product
- Products span the time frame claimed for Professional Experience Duration (PED)
